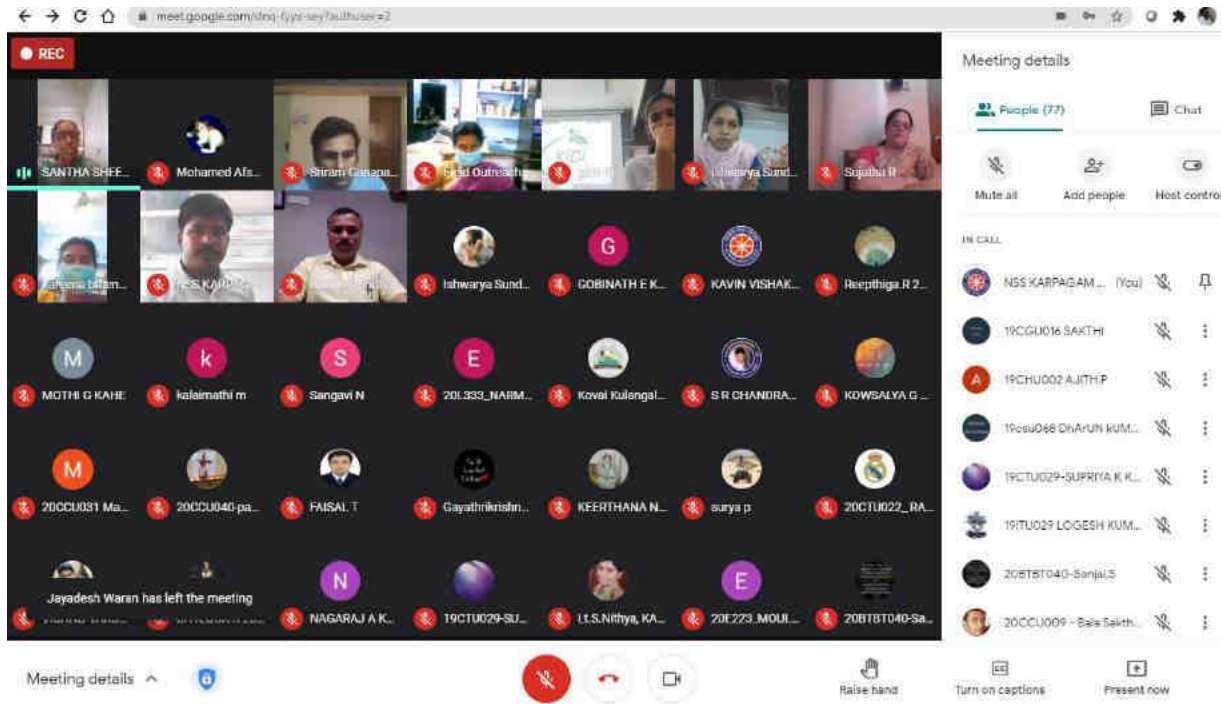

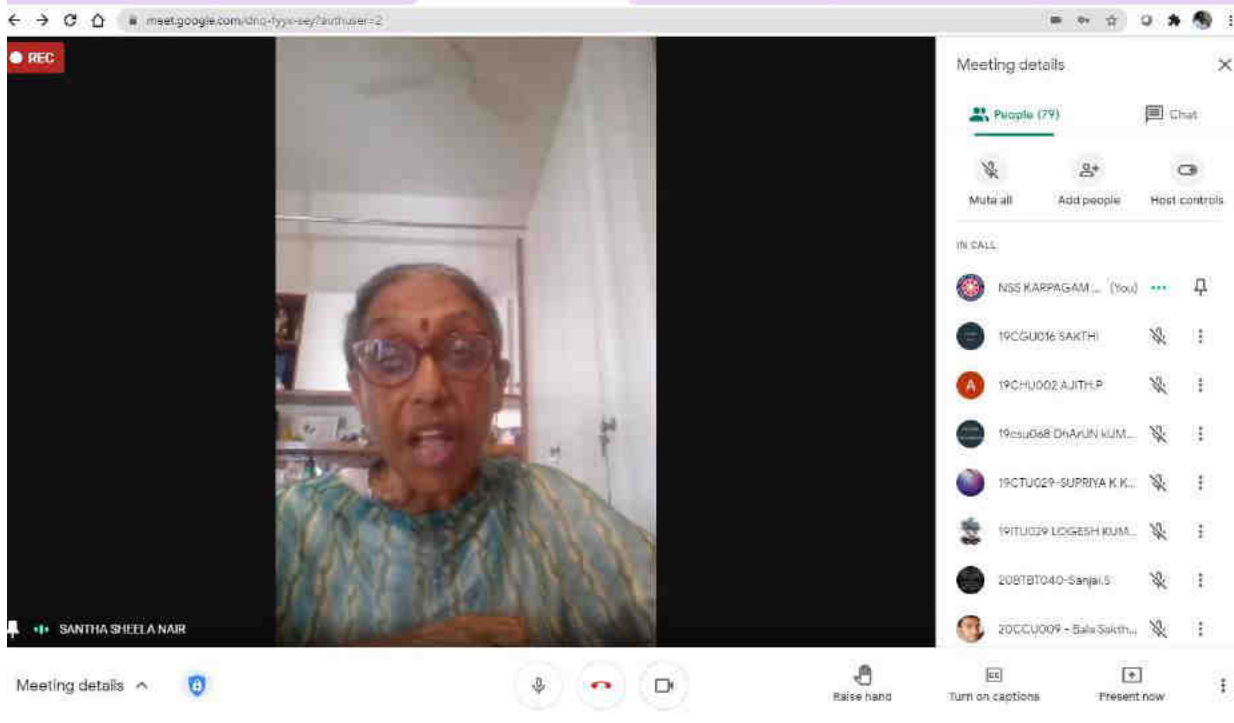

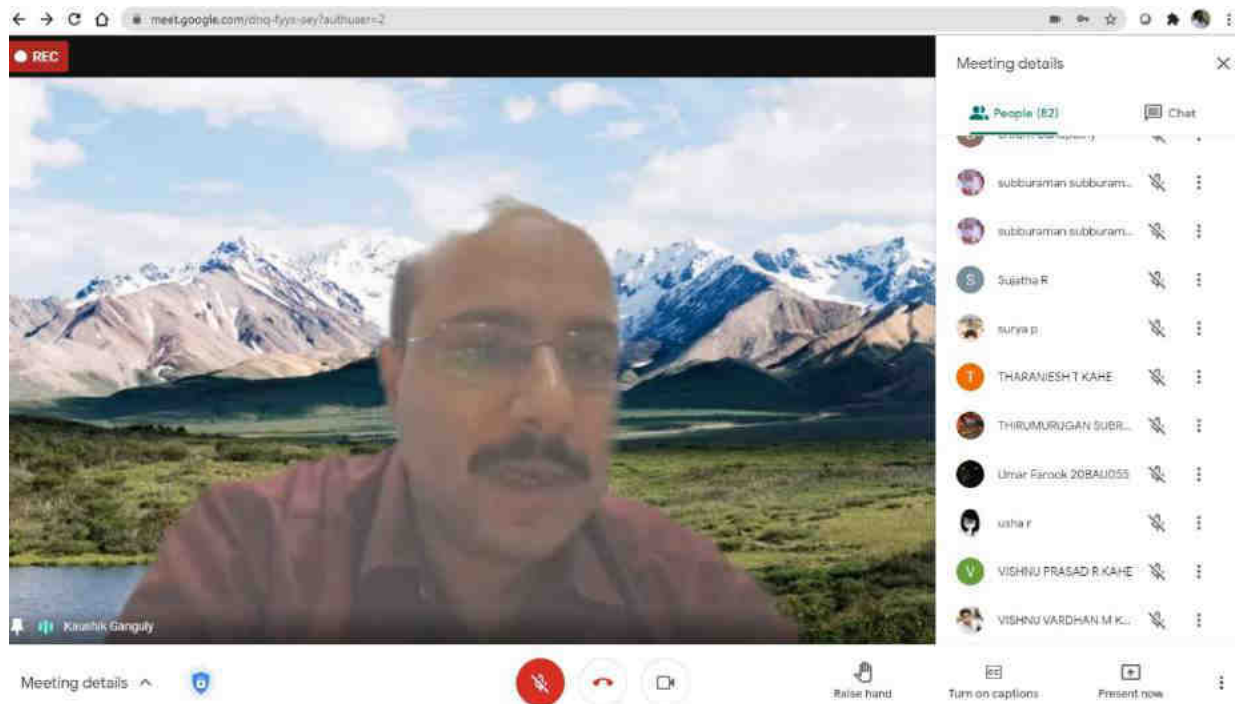
Dr. M. Deivanayagi addressed with welcome speech and the
