- Social assistance and basic needs fulfilment schemes will help in furnishing the first two objectives
- Inclusive economic growth models will allow opportunities for sustaining poverty escapes – an essential component of poverty eradication.



Our speaker explained that Poverty is more than just the lack of income or access to resources – it manifests itself in diminished opportunities for education, social discrimination and the inability to participate in decision-making processes. Under SDG, Poverty Eradication is one of the issues which has highly focused on.
